ISSUE STATEMENT

In the last few weeks, I have received countless emails requesting that the Huntington Beach City Council ask Bob Page, the Orange County Registrar of Voters (OCROV), to address concerns about voting security in Orange County and Huntington Beach.

On behalf of our constituents, we should extend an invitation for the OCROV to speak at an upcoming City Council meeting regarding election integrity and voter engagement. Insights on such topics as voter identification, election administration, and efforts to prevent voter fraud will help inform both the public and the City Council on how the OCROV manages elections, ensures transparency, and bolsters the democratic process.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Invite the Orange County Registrar of Voters to present at City Council meeting.
